And one guy (I won't say who, but you know who you are) is worried that the Sunday fellowship hour will run out of real sugar and he'll have to use the artificial sweetener that comes in "girly pink packets".

I know that real men don't use artificial sweetener that comes in girly pink packets and I wish I could guarantee that the Sunday fellowship hour will not run out of real manly sugar while I am in Africa. But I can guarantee that God will be with you, no matter what happens. So, why are you worried?

The same is true with the election, our finances, our health, our relationships, our congregation, our everything-else-in-life. God will be with us no matter what happens. So, why are worried?

In my own experience, I worry about things I cannot control. In time, I've come to realize that there are many things I cannot control, no matter how hard I try. And believe me, I have tried. And so I have decided to let God be in control of all of the things I cannot control. In the process, I have discovered that I am worrying far less than I used to worry. I'm even thinking about letting God control those things I can control. I'll let you know what happens.

In the meantime, there is a prayer that has helped many of us who worry. It was written by the Rev. Dr. Reinhold Neibuhr in 1933.

God, grant me the serenity to accept the things I cannot change,  
Courage to change the things I can,  
And wisdom to know the difference.

I hope this prayer will help you to give God the things you cannot control. May our Loving Lord grant us peace and free us from all anxiety.

## Expectations for Temporary Pastor/Head of Staff from TPNC

Our committee, which is actually a Temporary Pastor Nominating Committee rather than an Interim Pastor Nominating Committee, has been given the task, by the Session, of finding a qualified candidate to serve in the role of Temporary Pastor & Head of Staff during David Rodriguez' one year of absence in service to our country as a United States Navy Chaplain. Unlike an Interim Pastor role, this person will fill the position temporarily while we await David's return. We think of this period as a time of transition, rather than one of preparing for change and a new start. For this reason, we have identified the following priorities we consider important to our search:

In filling this temporary position, it is the desires of the TPNC to:

- Maintain and grow in God's ministries and current thriving programs
- To do what is best for
  - The congregation
  - Pastor David and his family
  - Pastor Kelsey and her family
- Maintain continuity and growth
  - It is our hope that this person will provide us the necessary support and leadership for our existing ministries and programs to thrive. Our goal is to have a temporary pastor in place with experience and a track record for encouraging leadership within our congregation and the support of our staff to carry out their respective roles with confidence.
  - We want to continue with the momentum that has been developed under David's and Kelsey's leadership.
- Match the candidate with our congregation
- Implement a smooth transition when David leaves, while he is gone, and, so importantly, when he returns
- Maintain financial viability
