# From the Office...



## RATS, MICE, ANTS... WE HAVE "CRITTERS" AGAIN!!

As many of you know, we don't have a daily custodian, so we need to find new ways to keep our church (especially the kitchen!) clean. I spoke with the Buildings & Grounds Elder (who I happen to live with!) and we decided to rearrange our garbage situation. There are two basic issues and simple solutions:

- 1) Often, I come to work and find a little food in the bottom of the huge garbage can in the kitchen. It seems wasteful to take trash out in the huge garbage bag that is nearly empty, so it's left for the time being (unfortunately it's bait for our 4- and 6-legged guests)
  - a. Solution: we put the extra-large trash cans in the furnace room and replaced it with a smaller kitchen can. We just ask that you please do take the trash out after every event or use. Replacement trash liners are in the bottom of the trash can.
  
- 2) The recycle and trash bins are a long way from the kitchen and it is dark and rainy!
  - a. Solution: We moved the regular trash and recycle bins to the corner just outside the kitchen back door near the bottom of the steps. The light by the back door lights up the area (light switch is in the hallway).



Of course, we have not done away with the larger trash cans. They are stored in the furnace room, just outside the kitchen door, and are easily pulled out for potlucks and other events that generate lots of trash.

As always, your help in keeping our church clean and tidy is greatly appreciated... not only by us, but by everyone who uses our facility. God bless you all!

We were also able to send 4 big bags of filler items, such as dolls, pencils, soccer balls, etc. to be used at the main collection center. If boxes are not full or if something needs to be replaced, the volunteers in Irvine fill up the boxes with these filler items.

Special thanks go to Drew Snyder who saw an opportunity to serve by recruiting for items, funds, and volunteers to pack up 102 boxes. Each box contained a personal letter from Drew along with her photo.

Another special thanks go to all the volunteers and especially to Jerry and Nancie Garcia, who not only worked during collection week, but also drove their truck pulling the trailer containing all the cartons of boxes to the Santa Rosa regional collection center. From there, the cartons are shipped to Irvine where each box is inspected and then recartoned for distribution throughout the world.

Many thanks go out to the congregation, participating churches, families, and individuals. Every gift-filled shoebox is a powerful tool for evangelism and discipleship – transforming the lives of children and their families through the Good News of Jesus Christ.
