


Abraham was, I am", and "I am the

We also received an email from Redwoods Presbytery that monies from Cents-Ability were used to feed a group of Marin County Coast Guard families who were not payed during the recent government shutdown.

Looking ahead, we have several Designated Fund Missions this year. Monies raised by these ministries are used for our various local and world-wide support activities.

We have set the first Meals-to-go fundraiser for Friday, April 5<sup>th</sup>. Tickets are now available for our delicious drive-by tri-tip meals that afternoon. Tickets are available from the office, Kitty Sandelin, Mark Smith, or Michele Young.

On Palm Sunday (April 14), we will have One Great Hour of Sharing. For over seventy years, Presbyterians have joined together in this ecumenical effort to share God's love through ministries that provide relief to those affected by disasters, food for the hungry, and support toward the self-development of poor and oppressed communities. We will have special One Great Hour of Sharing envelopes in the pew racks for your convenience. This offering will be taken during communion.

On May 18, we will be having our first packing party of 2019 that assembles the food packages in support of the Caritas Orphanage and troops in Djibouti. Thanks for your ongoing support of this ministry by contributing Peanut Butter, Beans and pectin based chewable vitamins (*such as SmartyPants available at Costco*) for the orphans and homemade cookies for the troops. Now is the time to start baking and freezing cookies. We hope to deliver them by the 4<sup>th</sup> of July to show our appreciation to their service. If you don't have room in your freezer, bring them to the church and we will freeze and store them. We use Pringle's cans to ship the cookies, so any used cans are appreciated.

We have set Saturday June 8<sup>th</sup> for a rummage sale to support our Uganda orphanage mission trip. This mission trip is scheduled for January 2020. The orphanage building construction is completed. Planning is underway to assemble and ship a modular solar electrical generating system to the orphanage next year as well. Please start collecting your gently used clothing, shoes and other household items (small appliances, etc.) to support this rummage sale.

The bicycle fundraiser Pedal-for-Protein is scheduled to begin in Orick on September 21 and terminate in Santa Rosa on September 28. The money raised from this ministry goes to supply food banks within our Presbytery. Ride Director, Patty Sanders will be presenting a minute for mission in June. Given the route, we may be asked to house the riders for a night as we have in the past.

We have been so successful with these activities because of your generous contributions.

May God be and the teachings of Jesus go forth in these ministries.

- Youth Choir: Initial practice was 1/16, with 6 youth attending. Practices will take place before youth group, 5:30-6:00 pm (Denise directing).
- **Hangout** starts up again 2-6-19, 5:30-7:00 pm. Leadership continues to be an issue.
- Galentine's Day 2/16: Sleepover for Youth Group girls grade 6-12, celebrating female friendships through fun and girly activities.
- Youth Group Planters: On a workday to be determined (2-2) the youth will assist in the building and filling

#### RESOURCE COUNCIL

• **Finance:** Presented three reports to Session: 1) Summary; 2) Income/expenses as of 12-31-18; 3)2018 budget; 4) 2019 budget. Together the reports showed that in 2018 income was \$248,223 while expenses were \$233,270, leaving a surplus

of \$14,953. The church did not have to use the 2017 surplus of \$15,384. The surplus on 1-1-19 is \$30,337.00. The budget for 2019 has an estimated income of \$245,00 and expenses of \$276,551, leaving a shortfall of \$31,551. The Session and committee, however, are "moving ahead in faith" that, with the new youth program developing, strong pastoral leadership, and involved and enthused congregation "growth" will flourish in 2019.

- **Buildings and Grounds:** Next meeting 1-31-19. The next workday 2-2-19.
- **Personnel:** There is an adjustment to David's Term of Call that requires adding the budget plus the manse credit to equal the board of pensions plus SECA.

#### FAMILY / OUTREACH COUNCIL


- Worship and Music: Will work with Buildings and Grounds on signage problem/project.
- **Christian Education:** Attempting to reach out to former leadership personnel to see if they will continue. 2-month planning sessions are being implemented. Work is underway to find an assistant for Alexis. "Break-fast" plans for a 30-hour famine on 4/27
- Congregational Care / Fellowship: Lenten lunches every Sunday in Lent will be planned.

#### Congregation Meeting minutes: January 20, 2019

- Cindy DeVries, treasurer, review the financial report, noting the positive surplus from 2018. Cindy also reviewed the 2019 approved budget noting the increase from 2018 resulting from increase in youth/family ministries (potential hire of Children's Assistant), return of Pastor David, enlarging worship team (adding paid musicians); also noted availability of 2-year surplus and commitment-vision to church growth for the future.
- Congregation approved Pastor Terms of Call: 2% salary increase and additional \$1805 added to reduce telecommute days from 15 to 10 days, with benefits increased accordingly effective January 1, 2019.

The next Session meeting is March 21 @ 6pm.
